CARES is a support group for those who have experienced the loss of a baby through miscarriage, ectopic pregnancy, stillbirth, or early infant death.

CARES offers parents an opportunity to express their thoughts and feelings in an accepting atmosphere.

During support group meetings, participants are given time to share their experiences, express their pain and grief, and respond to other parents. Active participation at the meetings is not required.

Participants may simply listen if they choose. The support group offers understanding and acceptance to parents throughout the grieving process.
