

INPATIENT CARDIOPULMONARY PROGRAM OUTCOMES AND PATIENT SATISFACTION – 2017

- 803 individuals served
- Average length of stay: 11 days
- 78% of cardiopulmonary patients returned home
- 97% of patients would recommend Sunnyview

The **Inpatient Cardiopulmonary Program** at Sunnyview Rehabilitation Hospital is proud of our clinical outcomes as well as our level of patient satisfaction. In 2017, the Cardiopulmonary Program served **803 patients**, with **97% of individuals reporting that they would recommend the program** to family and friends. The average length of stay for cardiopulmonary patients was **11 days**.

We realize that it is important for our patients to return home to their loved ones as soon as possible. **78% of our cardio-pulmonary patients returned back to their home** and community. This compares very favorably with other inpatient cardiopulmonary rehabilitation programs.

We are very proud of our **Ventilator Weaning Program** outcomes. In 2017, **73 patients** were admitted to the ventilator weaning program. The average length of stay for our ventilator patients was **27 days**, which compares very favorably with other inpatient ventilator weaning rehabilitation programs in the nation and region. In 2017, an astonishing **82% of our ventilator patients were able to come off the ventilator**.
