An annual mammogram is one of the best tools in the early detection of breast cancer. A mammogram is a low-dose X-ray that usually consists of multiple views of the breast.

For faster and more accurate results, we offer 3D mammography at all of our mammography locations. This superior imaging technology increases the accuracy in the detection of early invasive cancer across all age groups and breast densities.

Some patients require other types of imaging. This depends on their risk factors such as their age, genetic predisposition, breast density, or results from previous screenings.

- Breast MRI Magnetic resonance imaging is very effective at detecting small breast cancers in younger women and for staging cancer development.
- Breast ultrasound This technology is often used as a follow-up test after an abnormal finding on a mammogram, breast MRI or clinical breast exam.

- MRI-guided biopsy
- Surgical biopsy

Breast-Conserving Surgery

Breast-conserving surgery (or lumpectomy) is the most common form of breast cancer surgery. With a lumpectomy, the tumor and some surrounding tissue is removed.

Breast Reconstruction and Mastectomy

Mastectomy is surgery in which breast tissue, along with the cancerous tumor, is removed. Breast reconstruction may be performed simultaneously to mastectomy for immediate restoration of volume and shape, or at a later date if radiation therapy is necessary. Immediate reconstruction allows for a skin-sparing mastectomy in those who are appropriate candidates. The surgeons will consult with each patient to determine if immediate or delayed reconstruction is best.
