

At Eddy Memorial Geriatric Center, our goal is to provide the highest possible quality of life to residents with Alzheimer's disease and other types of memory loss. We want to be sure that every day is filled with moments that matter — moments of genuine pleasure, moments of genuine purpose and moments of genuine peace.

Our Program

The Life Enrichment Program provides residents with opportunities to exercise their social and cognitive functioning through a variety of "strength-based activity stations." The activity stations feature a large variety of authentic props and supplies known to be appealing to individuals with dementia. Residents participate either individually or in very small groups.

A staff facilitator, known as a "butterfly," quietly moves about the room, encouraging residents so that they do not become agitated, anxious or frustrated.

Some residents may actively "work" on projects and others might enjoy more relaxing pursuits. Some residents may be very social during the activity, while others may quietly pursue solitary interests at their own station.

Caregivers report significant reductions in wandering/falls, agitation, combativeness, sun-downing behaviors and other symptoms of dementia. In addition to reducing anxiety and restlessness, the program helps individuals by promoting engagement and a greater interaction with the world around them.
