

In 1997, The Eddy pioneered Alzheimer's education and residential care with our innovative Marjorie Doyle Rockwell Center in Cohoes. And, in 2006, we expanded that commitment with the opening of Eddy Alzheimer's Center at Hawthorne Ridge in East Greenbush.

Each community is thoughtfully designed for safety and independence, offering flexible schedules so residents can continue lifelong patterns and preferences; open and accessible country kitchens to encourage socialization; and interior corridors and outdoor garden pathways with continuous loops to prevent frustration and confusion.
