Are you having trouble paying for your prescription medication?

St. Peter's Health Partners Prescription Assistance Program can assist you in obtaining long-term prescription medications that you may otherwise not be able to afford. We do this by accessing the free or low-cost programs currently available through pharmaceutical companies.

How does it work?

It's easy ... just schedule an appointment and we will verify your eligibility, have you complete an application and obtain any other necessary documentation needed from your health care provider.

Once your application is submitted and approved by the pharmaceutical company, you can expect to receive medication in about a month. This will be shipped to either you or your health care provider, depending on the pharmaceutical company's policy.

Who is eligible?

In most cases, individuals must have a valid Social Security number and be uninsured or underinsured. In addition, there are specific income guidelines based upon the medication(s) you are requesting.

How do I apply?

Schedule an enrollment appointment by calling (518) 268-6442 or ask your provider to complete a Prescription Assistance referral form. At your appointment, be sure to bring the following:

- Proof of income
- Copy of most recent federal tax return (if available)
- A list of all current medications
